# Quick Guide for Mature Students

To qualify as a mature student for entry to a full-time undergraduate programme, you must: 1) be at least **23 years of age** on or before 1 January in the year of entry and; 2) have lived in an **EU/EEA Member State** for three of the last five years. All applications must be submitted to the CAO before the closing date of **February 1<sup>st</sup>** with an accompanying Statement of Intent.
