Taught Masters in CASSCS – Some Guidelines

- Typically full-year courses
- Three 12-week semesters
- 30 ECTS per semester
 - 30-30-30
- Modules usually 10 ECTS
 - 3 modules per semester
- Some 5 ECTS modules

Typical Workload & Expectations

- Contact hours
 - Typically 3 contact hours per 10 ECTS module per week
 - 2 contact hours per 5 ECTS module per week
- ‘Notional hours’
 - Reading, study time, assessment, tutor support, group work, fieldwork, experiential learning...
- Total hours (*in line with Bologna Process*)
 - 100 total hours per 5 ECTS module
 - 200 total hours per 10 ECTS module



Typical Workload & Expectations

- Typical assessment load
 - Diverse array of assessment methods and practices
 - Equivalent of 3000 words for a 5 ECTS module (6000 words for 10 ECTS)
 - 30 ECTS Dissertation usually around 15,000 words
- Your responsibilities
 - Be prepared
 - Be engaged
 - Turn work in on time
 - Take advantage of opportunities presented to you



Points of Contact

- First point of contact is usually your **Programme Director**
- **Head of Discipline** and **Head of School** can also help in most situations
- Postgraduate students should contact the **College Office** for the following reasons:
 - Leave of Absence
 - Request to exit with Postgraduate Diploma
 - Withdrawal from the programme
 - Deferral to following academic year
 - Financial hardship

- Often related to a specific grant-funded research project (sometimes very large in scale)
- Projects are usually pre-defined by the supervisor(s) with a good deal of specificity

2) General Applications to Existing PhD Programmes

- The PhD Student defines their own project and sources their own supervisor(s)
- It is possible to pursue a PhD on a non-funded (fee paying) basis, though there are also both internal and external funding opportunities

PhD Position in Computational and Experimental Mechanobiology (Cancer)

Applications are invited from suitably qualified candidates for a full-time, fully-funded position that will investigate the mechanobiology of tumour growth and therapy resistance. This position is funded by a **European Research Council Starting Grant** and will be under the supervision of **Dr Eoin McEvoy**, Associate Professor in Biomedical Engineering. The researcher will join Dr McEvoy's group, which brings together expertise in biophysical modelling, active cell biomechanics, and *in-vitro* tumour models. The group's overall focus is to develop advanced computational and experimental models that provide a mechanistic understanding of cell and tissue remodelling in cancer and disease, motivating novel mechano-therapeutics and treatment strategies. One of the most important parts of choosing a research programme is finding a supervisor who has relevant expertise in your area of interest. **This is crucial if you are defining your own project!** When you find a supervisor who aligns with your research interests, you should make contact with the relevant potential supervisor/lecturer/Professor or University of Galway staff member to discuss matters further. **You should do this as a first step before formally applying.** They can also advise you on how to apply to become an University of Galway research student.

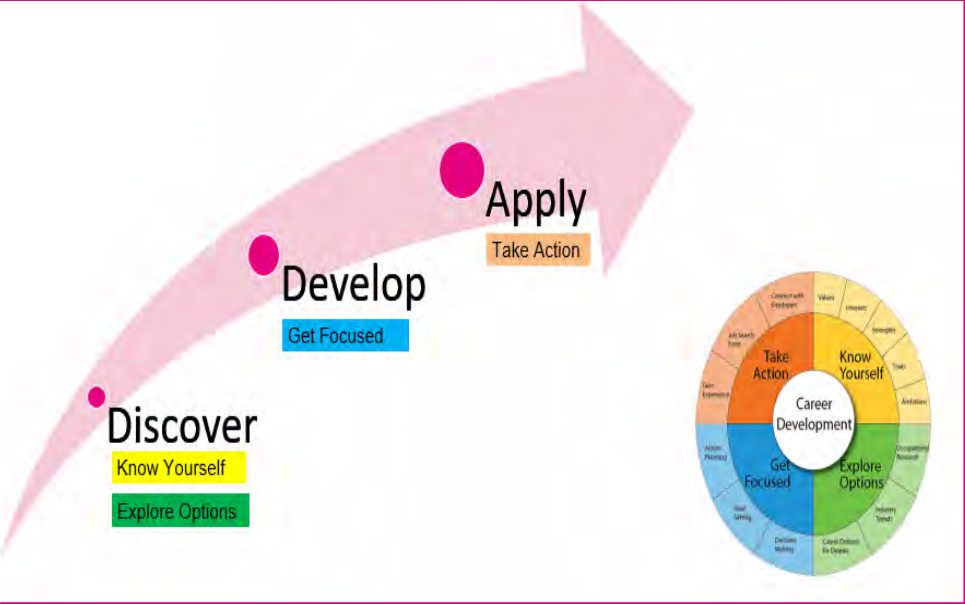

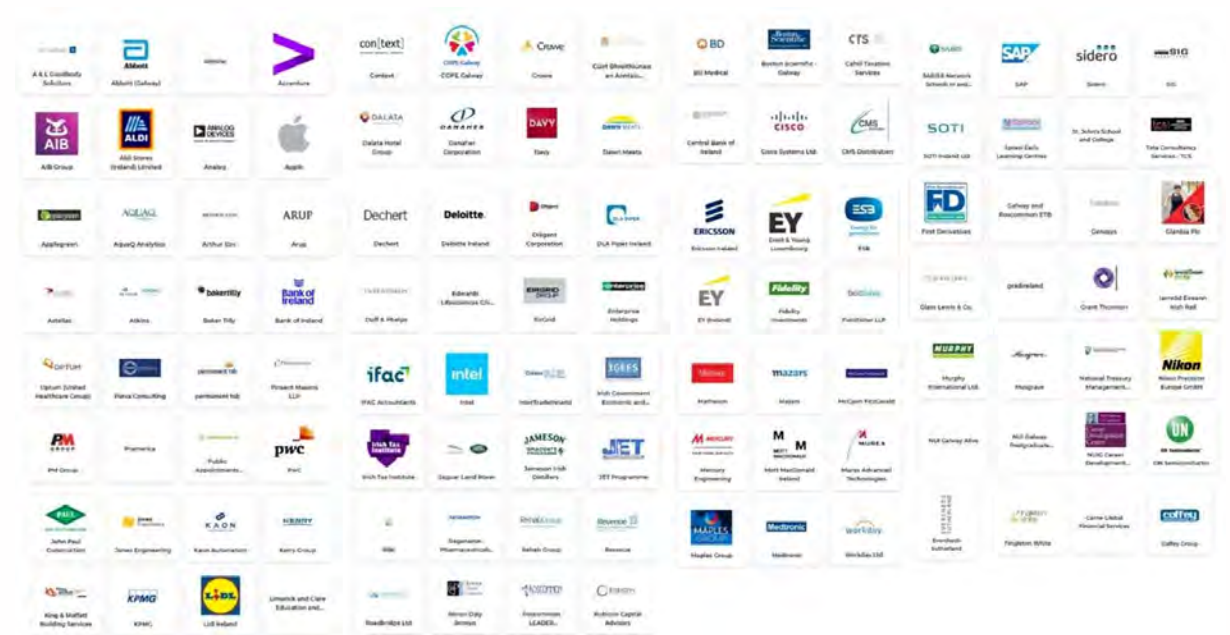

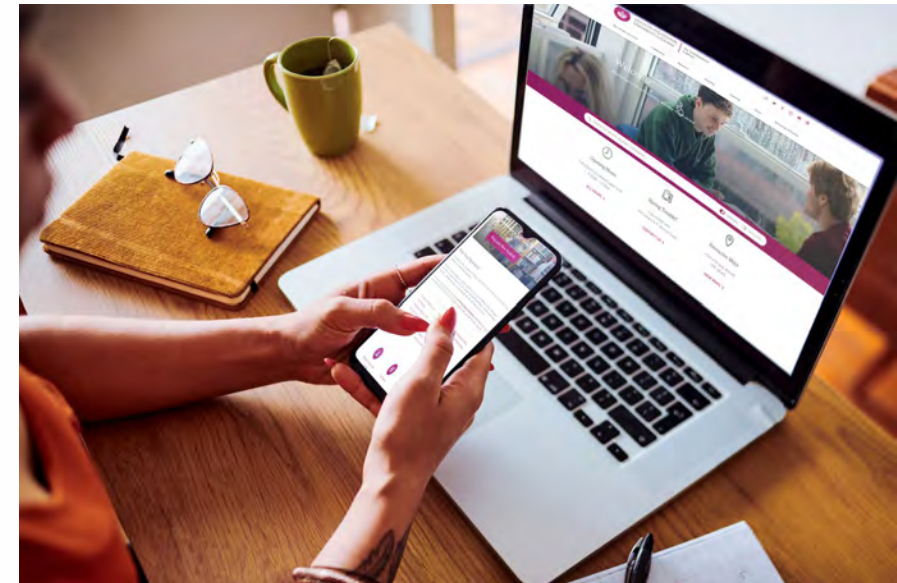
