# Excursion 3

## Discover the largest of all Aran Islands - Inis Mór

Enjoy a short journey on the **ferry from the small port of Rossaveal**. Rossaveal is approximately a 40 minute drive along the Connemara Coast. On Inis Mor you will enjoy a guided minibus tour of the island with a local driver/guide, who lives on the Island.

Inis Mor is the most famous of the three Aran Islands' historical sites. Visions of ancient druids and mythical High Kings come to mind as you explore the rocky landscape and mysterious ruins. Jutting out into the Atlantic Ocean, you can see the undulating Irish coastline as roaring waves crash against the base of the sea cliffs. Wear suitable footwear for uneven terrain and don't forget to wrap up warm. The wind whips at a ferocious pace around the sea cliffs, and you'll want to stay cosy as you discover the delights of the islands. **Your tour includes a visit to the spectacular Dún Aonghasa**, which is an ancient stone fort that sits on a towering 100-metre cliff on the edge of Inis Mór. We encourage you to book this excursion fast, as it will be the one which sells out first. This experience is one you don't want to miss it!
