The Programme

Students who choose to complete their foundation programme through an Irish University have the great advantage of studying through English, developing a strong understanding of the Irish culture and adapting to the teaching style used in Irish Institutions. This will ensure they are fully prepared to commence their chosen Degree programme in Ireland.

Books/Materials

Students will be provided with mandatory text books, at an approximate cost of €250.

Uniform

Students wear a uniform to class each day. The uniforms will be provided by the college uniform supplier upon registration, costing approximately €150. The uniform consists of a pair of black trousers, a black jumper, two white shirts, a college tie/scarf and name badges. The uniform is compulsory.

Health Insurance

Health insurance is mandatory for visa purposes and for registering with the Irish Immigration Authority and obtaining your Irish Residence Permit (IRP). Accommodation

The College's provider of student accommodation is located at Castle Gardens, Bunratty Village. The cost of the accommodation for 2022/2023 was \leq 4,375 (35 weeks x \leq 125, please note number of weeks may change) plus a security deposit of \leq 500. There is also a utilities charge of \leq 750 and this will be offset against the utility bills.

Fee Regulations
